Board services:

Pasture Board-

Includes pasture maintenance ie rotating to rest pastures, mowing, spraying and fences. Water and mineral as well as hay in the winter months are provided. Horses are counted and monitored for any obvious injuries or illnesses. We will not pull your horse out regularly and examine.

Run outs-

Runouts include hay twice a day except on turnout day when they will get hay in the evening only. Grain twice a day. Supplements will be added as requested at no additional charge (provided by owner). Water and mineral are also provided. We will turn your horse(s) out and bring them in. Maintenance of the runouts is provided and includes cleaning every other day, grading and reapplying sand at least annually, cleaning the automatic waterers and troughs as needed. Panels/gates will be repaired and/or replaced as needed. Fly sprayers and fans will be provided as needed and is included in your board. Turn out pastures will be maintained by TEC.

Stalls Full Care-

Stall boarding includes hay twice a day except on turnout day when they will get hay in the evening only. Grain twice a day. Supplements will be added as requested at no additional charge (provided by owner). Water and mineral are also provided. We will turn your horse(s) out and bring them in. Blanketing and un blanketing as well as fly masks/sheets on and off will be provided. Maintenance of the stalls is provided and includes cleaning every other day and stripping and disinfecting at least monthly. We will rinse the water buckets out each time the stall is cleaned and disinfect weekly. Fly sprayers and fans will be provided as needed and is included in your board. Turn out pastures will be maintained by TEC.

Stalls Self Care-

Stall boarding includes hay twice a day except on turnout day when they will get hay in the evening only. Grain twice a day. Supplements will be added as requested at no additional charge (provided by owner). Water and mineral are also provided. We will turn your horse(s) out and bring them in. Maintenance of the stalls is provided except cleaning. Cleaning must be done by owner at least every other day and stripped and disinfected monthly. Pelletized bedding is provided by the owner or purchased from TEC at cost. (Shavings are only used for specific situations) You will also be required to rinse your buckets out every other day. Disinfecting of buckets will be done weekly by TEC. Fly sprayers and fans will be provided as needed and is included in your board. Turn out pastures will be maintained by TEC.

Other amenities-

The arena and round pen are provided for all boarders. Please be respectful of others using them. If we are hosting an event, the arena will be closed. We also close the arena occasionally for those boarders needing to practice their sport requiring the whole arena; barrels, poles, etc.

The lounge and bathroom are also available for your use.

First aid kit and other medical products are located in the bathroom for both horses and people. These products are provided for emergencies and not for on-going care.

The tack room is designed for one spot per horse. Please do not exceed the space allotted to you.

Trails are maintained by TEC and volunteers. If you plan to use the trails, please sign up to help keep them clean and safe.

Additional services:

- 1. Pasture feeding Monday-Friday \$60.00 or \$5.00 each time
- 2. Hay chaff \$15.00 per 50 pound bale
- 3. Quarantine is available on a case by case basis

There will be additional charges for medical treatment going forward. This will be handled on a case by case basis. Some examples would be wrapping wounds and abscesses, treating scratches and rain rot, etc. We will not give injections and we have the right to refuse medical treatment if the horse is potentially dangerous.

Worming will be handled by Trimble Equine Center beginning Jan. 1, 2019. All horses will have a fecal test done in November and June. If parasite count is low, we will worm with a one dose wormer in December and July. If the fecal test results show more than low, we will use a 5 day power pack or doctor recommended wormer followed by an additional fecal test 30 days after completing the power pack. We will also be doing a 1 dose worming in March for bots. Both Dr. Jackson and Dr. Brisbane have recommended this as the worms seem to be building up a tolerance to the worming typically done. This is all done for the health of your horse(s) as well as everyone using the facilities. This is all covered in your board.
